Singapore, 4th March 2011: Adecco Singapore was recognised for services to sport in Singapore at the recent Singapore National Olympic Council Multi-Million Dollar Awards Presentation Ceremony for the 19th Commonwealth Games and the 16th Asian Games 2010, held in February at the Grand Copthorne Waterfront Hotel.

A long-timer supporter of sport in Singapore through various work related programmes, Adecco partners with professional and amateur athletes that are entering the workforce at the end of their sporting careers, providing them with education and advice about the labour market, job-seeking techniques and linking them to employers when possible.
